## 2003 Pinot Noir

This elegant wine is from a small local producer in the Northern Willamette Valley.

The first taste gives you concentrated flavor with layers of berry, black cherry, toasty vanilla and finishes with creamy notes. This velvety Pinot Noir is perfect with filet minion and mild dishes which will augment the wines subtle depth.

The wine is produced exclusively from our estate-grown fruit of the Filippo and Olivia Vineyards. This vineyard combination yields a complete fruit flavor and the use of 10% whole clusters and 40% new French oak barrels add depth and complexity.
